

\* THE SHOULDER SLOPE USUALLY VARIES FROM 1/2"/ft.(4%) TO 3/4"/ft.(6%). HOWEVER, THE SHOULDER SLOPE SHOULD BE MAINTAINED WHEN CONSTRUCTING THE DRIVEWAY.

FOR GRADE CHANGES GREATER THAN THOSE SHOWN IN THE FIGURE ABOVE, VERTICAL CURVES AT LEAST TEN (10) FEET LONG SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AND LENGTH "A" SHALL BE INCREASED.


GRADES (G2) SHALL BE LIMITED TO FOURTEEN PERCENT (14%) FOR MINIMUM USE DRIVEWAYS AND FIVE PERCENT (5%) TO EIGHT PERCENT (8%) FOR LOW, MEDIUM, OR HIGH VOLUME DRIVEWAYS WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY.



\* WHERE THE ROADWAY SLOPE IS 3:1 OR FLATTER, THE DRIVEWAY EMBANKMENT SLOPE WITHIN THE ROADWAY R/W SHALL BE 10:1 OR FLATTER.

WHERE THE ROADWAY SLOPE IS STEEPER THAN 3:1, A GUIDE RAIL IS USUALLY INSTALLED AT THE TOP OF THE ROADWAY SLOPE AND STEEPER SLOPES ARE PERMISSIBLE ON THE DRIVEWAY WITHIN THE R/W.
